# Ronald McDonald House Movie Guide



Movies in the House theater provide weekend joy and diversion for our families. Thank you for your interest in volunteering with this program.

## Volunteer Groups

- Size—2 to 6 volunteers.
- Age—at least 13 years old, with one adult present to supervise if your group includes anyone under 18.

# Timing

- Volunteers arrive a half hour before showtime to prep popcorn and get set up.
- Showtime is at **6:30 pm on Friday and Saturday**, and at **6 pm on Sunday**. If no families show up for at least 20 minutes after the scheduled start, feel free to call it a night and check out at the Front Desk.
- Plan for 20-30 minutes after the movie ends to finish cleaning.

## Movie Choices—G or PG rated only

- DVD or Blu-ray disc format (note: Ultra HD Blu-ray is incompatible with our player).
- Fire Stick/Roku Streaming Stick instructions are posted—an easy way to screen a G or PG movie you own or rent with **your personal Fire Stick/Roku Streaming Stick and remote**.
- Groups have the best success aiming for preschool to grade school age audiences.

## Snacks

- We are limited to **individual bags** of microwave popcorn or non-messy snacks and or candy (no chocolate, please!). All must be **commercially packaged and served unopened**.
- Plan for 15-20 movie fans.
- The House provides bottled water—no other beverages are permitted in the theater.

## Movie Procedure

- 1. Make sure everyone on your team is **healthy with no symptoms of illness** and has reviewed our Volunteer Guidelines (separate document).
- 2. Fill out a Group Sign-In form at the Front Desk when you arrive with everyone adding their name.
- 3. House staff will take you to the theater and assist with the video equipment, lights, etc.
- 4. When the movie ends, thoroughly clean the theater, following all instructions posted inside.
- 5. All clean? Grab your movie, any garbage, and the theater key after you lock up.
- 6. Return to the Front Desk to hand off key and garbage and sign out, with the pink copy as your receipt.

#### Important Reminders

- Any photos you take must be limited to your group—please do not include our children or their families.
- An adult volunteer must stay in the theater throughout the movie.
